



In addition to these grant programs, I want to also provide you with an update on our plans for the COBE (Committee on Baccalaureate Expansion) Grant Program. As you know, we have recently submitted a proposal for funding through the Lumina Foundation Making Opportunity Affordable (MOA) Grant Program. If we receive this funding of \$500,000 annually for four years, these funds will be combined with COBE funds to address the goal of graduating increasing numbers of Wisconsin citizens, in partnership with WTCS, WAICU, and DPI. If we do not receive these funds from Lumina, we are considering using the COBE funds to address UW System projects to expand baccalaureate degrees, within the context of the plans developed in the MOA proposal.
